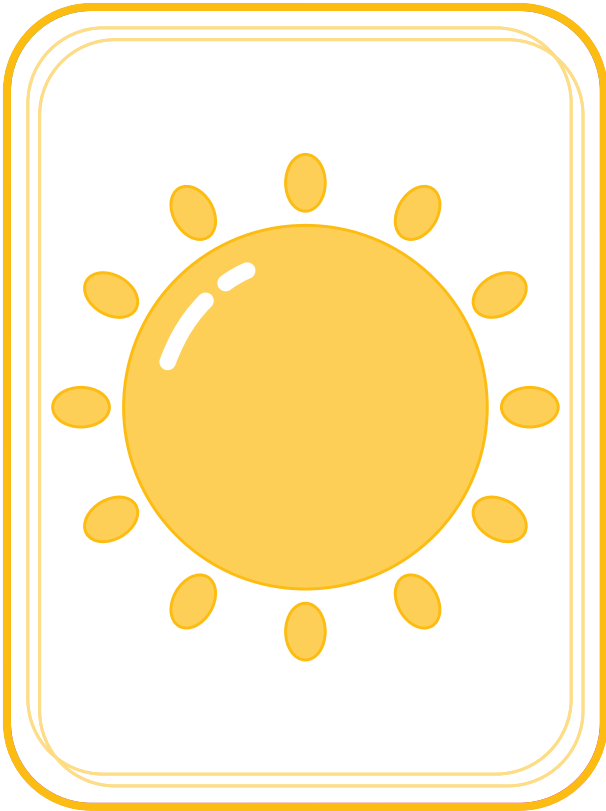




Front Side, V6, Page 1



Rain

Rain falls from the clouds in little water drops. The drops make tiny circles when they hit the ground.



Sunny

The sun looks like a big, bright yellow circle in the sky. It gives light during the day.



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Cloudy

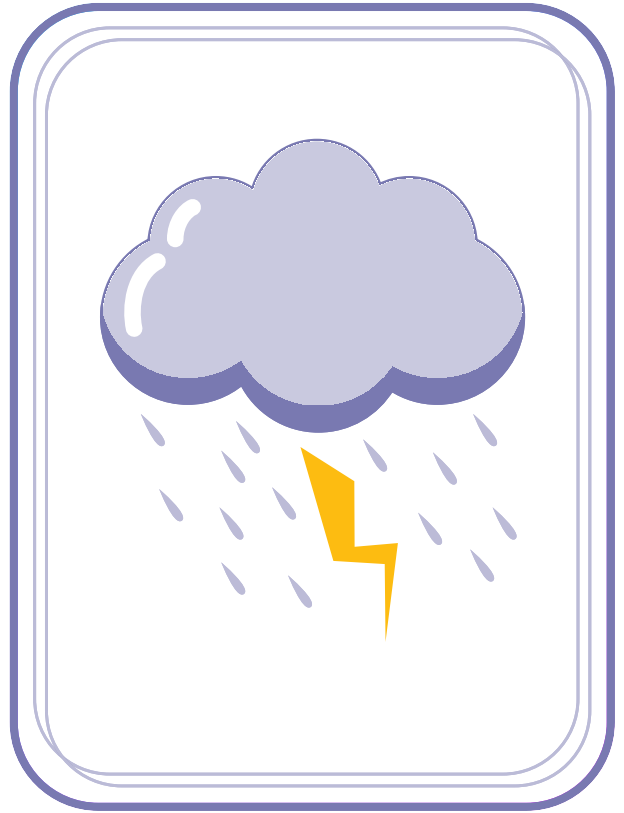
Clouds cover most of the sky. They look soft, puffy, or flat, and are white or gray.



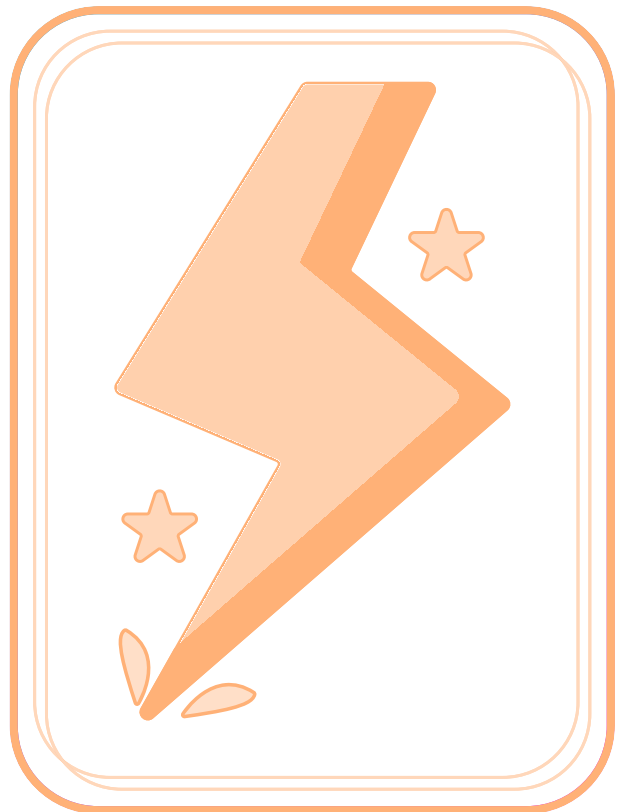
Snow

Storm

A storm happens when the clouds are heavy with rain. You might see lightning in the sky and hear thunder.



Windy

Wind moves the air and makes things sway. It can push leaves, hats, or doors.



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Lightning

Lightning is a bright flash of light in the sky that can look like a line or a zigzag. It comes from clouds during a storm.



Fog

Fog is a cloud that touches the ground. It makes the air look white or gray.

Hail

Hail falls from clouds as small balls of ice. The pieces can be round, hard, and cold to touch.



Rainbow

A rainbow can appear when sunlight shines through rain. It looks like a curved line made of colors.



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Aurora

An aurora is light that moves across the night sky. It can look like green, pink, or purple waves.



Ice

Ice is water that has frozen and turned solid. It feels cold, hard, and smooth to touch.
